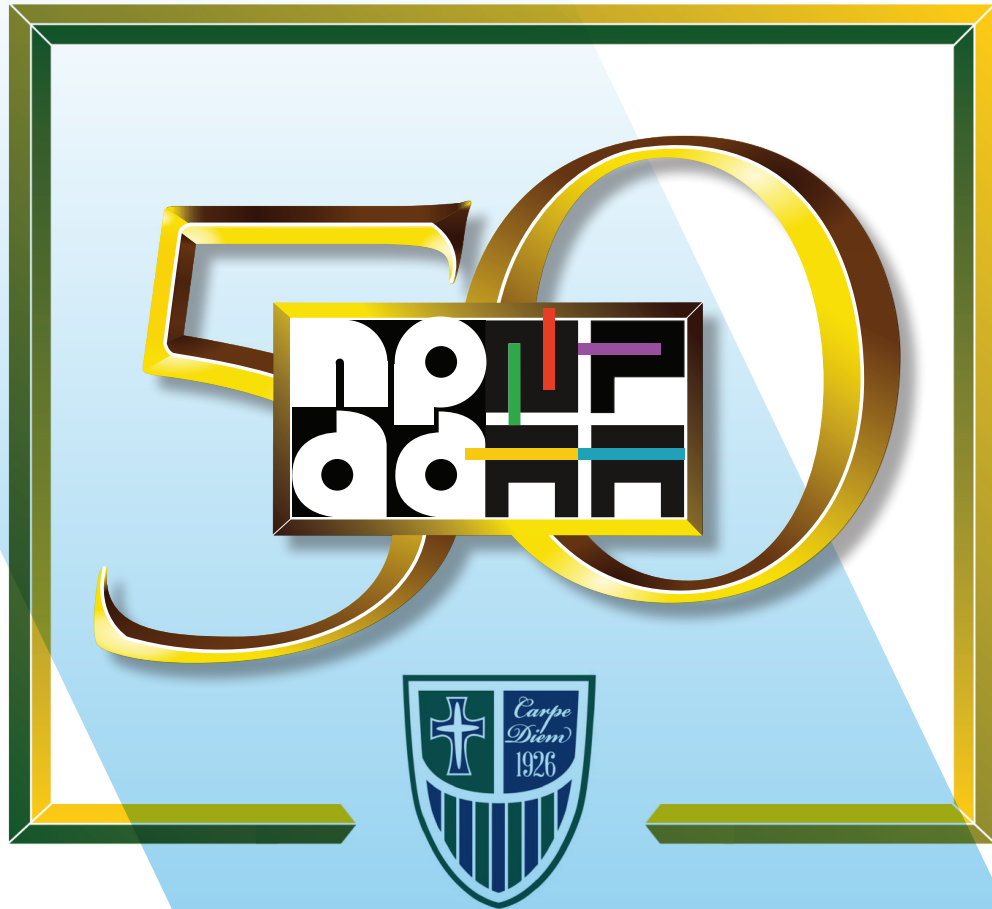


ARTchive Party

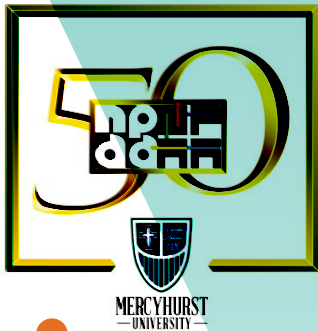
We had a lot of fun going down the history path together and enjoyed some pizza, beer and wine along the way. CHEERS !

The 50th exhibit has an open theme.

Mercyhurst Gallery can accommodate 50 pieces comfortably. In order to include as many artists as possible, we are limiting entry to **one** piece per artist on a first come basis. Artworks should not exceed 40" width.

Work should not have been displayed in a previous NPAA Exhibit.

Due to planned events within the space during the exhibit, all 3-D artworks must be installed or placed against a wall (meaning they cannot be viewed in the round).

3D works must fit on the pedestals that are available for our use; most have a display surface between 18" x 30" wide with varying heights.

Free standing or suspended works cannot exceed a 40" diameter footprint and will also be placed against the wall.

Artists with small scale works are encouraged to partner together. On average the gallery can comfortably fit approximately 50 works of various sizes.

Work must be framed, wired, labeled and ready to hang. Work with saw tooth hangers will not be accepted. All work must be original, clean and pose no hazard.

Promotion:

NPAA reserves the right to reproduce the work for promotion of the group and the exhibit.

Reasonable care will be taken with all submitted work. NPAA will not be responsible for loss, damage, or theft of any work.

Artists are responsible for any extra insurance on their art outside of the Gallery's rental insurance.
