SURREALECTRIC

INTRICATE DIGITAL DREAMSCAPES FOR THE 21ST CENTURY



"Surrealectric is a first of its kind all digital art exhibition with a limited-edition 3D stereo kit with images and a special 3D viewer.

This unique series is the result of expanding my creative sphere into the world of 3D fractals and mathematical art. This genre of New Media Art is the wild west of the computer world with difficult-to-use specialized software that is not always stable.

The works in this exhibition are digital stories of fragmented dreams and alternate realities. Included are both micro and macro visions of hidden worlds involving a mix of bright colors and textures with geometric and analog shapes representing a range of metaphorical, abstract and surreal settings to engage and challenge the viewer."





NPAA ARTIST MEMBERS: JASON AMANTANGELO ANTONIO HOWARD

NPAA Artist Members Jason Amantangelo and Antonio Howard created a mural for Erie Arts & Culture, part of United Way of Erie's Safer Pathways Initiative. Erie Arts & Culture are planning 50 murals along the walking routes to schools on the East side of town. *Alphawall* is located at 1946 East Lake Avenue, Erie PA.

"Bight colors and geometric shapes hide a secret message inside the mural. With the help of the community, a palette was born. We started by going door to door and asking people in the neighborhood what colors best describe the optimistic hope when they think of their community. The second part, when you think of this color, what are a couple of words that best describe home? A vast range of colors was given and just as many words.

When you look at the mural, you will see a spectrum of bright colors against a black background. All these colors reflect the diversity of all the individuals that call this place home. The background was used to highlight each person and let each member stand on their own while also working together to make a composition. If you look closely, you will see many letters across the image. These represent the answers given. Suppose you think of a word search with a hidden message inside the painting. How many words can you make?"

Inner City Neighborhood Art House Passport to the Arts

Arts Education for Inner-City Youth

The Inner-City Neighborhood Art House provides a safe, nourishing and caring environment for youth after school and during the summer. A ministry of the Benedictine Sisters of Erie, the Art House mission is to enable youth to experience beauty, grow in positive self-expression and self-discipline, and develop into full and productive human beings.

Youth ages 7-18 who live in Erie's inner city are invited to attend the Neighborhood Art House at no cost for instruction in the visual, performing, and literary arts and in environmental action. This instruction includes semester-length classes and private music lessons; students can also choose a time for tutoring and for one-on-one reading with an adult volunteer.

The students of the Neighborhood Art House 2022 Taste of the Arts – Passport to the Arts was held September 13, 2022. Upon entering the Art House, guests were greeted with art displayed and proudly presented by student artists eager to answer questions about their artwork. This year's featured live auction artist was Sergey Ulasavets, age 13, whose special talent is sure to draw attention. There also were opportunities to interact directly with the students and to observe demonstrations of the various artforms they have

Congratulations to Barbara Yerace for being accepted into the Erie Art Museum's 98th Annual Nicole & Harry Martin Spring Show!



"In Celebration of the Bear is the fifth piece in a series of Spirit Animals that I have been studying. A few years back I found this bear head made of paper mache at a local department store, I immediately could see it covered in glass beads. As the COVID-19 pandemic hit and we were quarantined at home, I began to focus on completing the bear. It took many quiet and lonely hours to finish, thus lending itself to my inner exploration and self examination. So appropriate that the bear spirit animal symbolizes introspection and spiritual enlightenment. The bear energy helps us to meditate by silencing our minds and helps us to discover why we are here and what is our soul's purpose. Using glass beads, the circle and spiral are repeated throughout the piece. The circle is a universal symbol that represents self, wholeness and our life cycle from birth to death. The spiral is a reference to intuition, representing growth and evolution of one's identity with the universe. During this time of isolation and separation from our family and friends we have been forced into a time of questioning, "Why are here and what is my soul's purpose?," a lesson that I think the universe was imposing on us. As we emerge from the pandemic, I hope that we can adopt the strength and wisdom of the Bear Spirit Animal."

SARAH'S BAKED BUFFALO CHICKEN DIP

Ingredients

- 4 boneless chicken breasts
- 2, 8oz. Philadelphia Cream Cheese
- 1 bottle Frank's Buffalo Hot Wing Sauce
- 1, 8oz. bag shredded cheddar cheese
- 1 bottle spicy ranch


Instructions

- 1.Boil and then pull apart chicken into strips, add to mixing bowl (using your table mixer on a very low setting since the ingredients are VERY dense you want them to mix but NOT be pulverized)

- 4. Bake at 350 degrees for 1 hour or until "baked" on top

Gannon University just finished their newest residence hall, South Hall, located on corner of Eighth and Sassafras streets. South Hall welcomed residents into the \$11 million dollar facility on August 19, 2022.

South Hall boasts four floors of single and multistudent suites. Students enjoy tranquil color palette as the renovation aesthetic aims to mirror a different phase of daytime across each floor. The fourth-floor community lounge offers four functional garage doors that will open in the warm months to overlook I-HACK and will draw in the morning's rising sun. The third floor utilizes beach glass tones to mimic daytime, and the second floor moves into a dropping sunset color scheme with bold oranges and yellows. The lower level aptly provides muted nighttime ambience in its shared lounge.
