GRANDMA'S MACARONI SALAD

NPAA Secretary, Sarah Hlusko Everhart, makes her grandmother's macaroni salad year round!

Ingredients

- elbow macaroni
- mayonnaise
- green olives with pimento AND juice
- salt and pepper
- hard boiled eggs
- onion
- celery/hearts
- paprika

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Hard boil eggs, soak in cold water, then refrigerate
2. Boil macaroni, drain
3. Once cool, add
 - mayonnaise
 - green olives **AND** juice
 - salt and pepper
 - hard boiled eggs, chopped
 - onion, chopped
 - celery/hearts, chopped
 - paprika, to taste
4. Refrigerate overnight
5. Serve and enjoy!

RECENTLY OUR OWN BARBARA YERACE WAS AWARDED AN ARTIST IN RESIDENCE PROGRAM AT NEMACOLIN WOODLANDS RESORT. HERE IS AN OVERVIEW OF HER STAY THERE IN HER OWN WORDS.

“Nemacolin Woodlands is an exclusive resort situated in the Laurel Highlands in Farmington, PA. This 2000 acre resort was founded by 84 Lumber owner Joe Hardy. Along with his daughter Maggie, they’ve developed the resort into a magical get away, with three hotels, a spa and a golf course. In addition they also have a private art collection featuring over 1000 pieces of art worth approximately \$43 million as of 2013. And most importantly, they recognized the benefits and importance of establishing an environment to promote and foster creativity within the grounds. With that in mind they have overseen the development of an art department where guests can take art classes, such as painting, jewelry making and other crafts.

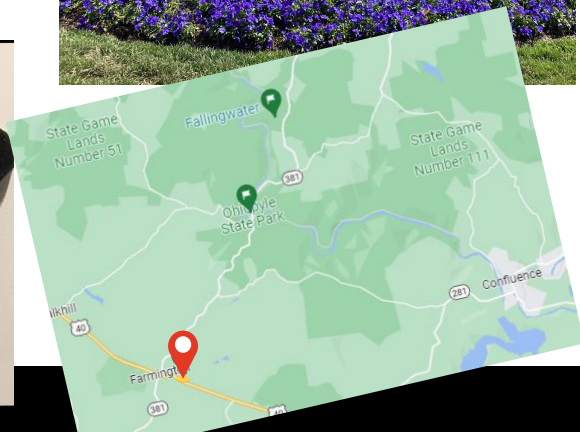
The Artist in Residence program was developed four years ago. The program allows guests of the resort to observe the resident artists learning and expressing and creating art in their respective crafts. Lodging, food and a stipend are provided to the artists in the program.

My residency took place from April 1-29, 2022. My proposal was to work on my beaded Spirit Animal stoles, particularly the red tail hawk. I had one month to super focus on my work and interact with the guests sharing my techniques and ideas.

While in the residency, I also visited Frank Lloyd Wright's "Fallingwater" home, designed in 1935 as a vacation home for the Kaufmann Family of Pittsburgh and completed in 1939. The Laurel Highlands are also home to a variety of other historical locations, namely Fort Necessity National Battlefield, General Braddock's grave and Ohiopyle State Park.

This was truly a wonderful and inspiring experience that allowed me to step out of my normal routine, 'having the luxury' to concentrate on my work in a most beautiful setting.”

PACAPALOOZA: UPCOMING ART AUCTION AT PACA

The event entitled PACAPalooza will run August 12-14, 2022. The event is free and open to the public. It will consist of plays, music, spoken word, art shows and the like. The auction will take place on Sunday, August 14th at around 2:00 PM. This is the eighth time we have run this event and it is very popular.

This will be a joint fundraiser for PACA and the NPAA.

Intake will be at PACA on Sunday, August 7th between 10:00 AM and 2:00 PM, and on Monday from 12:00 to 5:00 PM. The PACA team will catalog every piece. All the pieces will be hung and labeled. Participating artists are encouraged to submit their names prior to the sale so that PACA is able to promote their work specifically in the week leading up to the event.

Art may be purchased by patrons during the event/show at their listed price. The last time this event was held, several pieces did in fact sell prior to the auction. All pieces which do not sell during the three day event will be sold at the auction. The artist will receive 60% of the sale price. A 40% commission will be charged and split equally, 20% each, between PACA and the NPAA. PACA will be responsible for all costs relating to promotion. We have a promotional budget of over a thousand dollars.

Artists may also set a starting bid of 50% of the asking price if they choose.

The last time this fundraiser was held both organizations earned approximately two thousand dollars for their general fund.

PACA will support the auction by including pieces from their own collection including works by Joseph Plavan, Sister Angelica, and more. Of course, the NPAA will receive a full commission on all of these works.
